

## Spring Burndown:

An application of Atrazine or Metribuzin done early spring will put you further ahead when it is time to plant.

Atrazine will give you more residual for your corn or milo, while Metribuzin will give you residual for your soybeans.

We STRONGLY suggest laying down residual early spring, this only helps you when weeds start to emerge.

## Wheat Top-Dress

**Why do we top-dress wheat?**

There are several ways to “top-dress” wheat. One is to fertilizer, we do this to ensure the plant has the nutrients to continue to thrive. Second, application of chemical, this is done to ensure those pesky weeds do not damage yield and overtake the crop. Third, is applying them both together for a one trip application.



## Alfalfa (Dormancy Weed Control)

Did you have problem pigweeds in your alfalfa? If so, you are not the only one.

Now would be a good time to get a herbicide program in place for your alfalfa. Right before it breaks dormancy is the optimum time to apply herbicide.
